Today, CFHLA was proud to be the host sponsor once again, for the **2024 State of Orange County Address** presented by **Orange County Mayor Jerry L. Demings**.

During the address, we were thrilled to hear the positive news that the Central Florida hospitality and tourism industry generated a record \$87.6 billion in economic impact and supported nearly 40% of our local jobs last year. Additionally, Mayor Demings shared an overview of the

accomplishments and challenges that we've face here in Orange County, as well as provided a shared vision on how we are "building better together."

**Hurricane Preparedness Seminar & Sales Tax Holiday** 



As we officially kick off the 2024 Hurricane season, this week the CFHLA Engineers Council hosted their annual Hurricane Preparedness Seminar at the Sheraton Orlando Lake Buena Vista Resort (Thank You, Collin Mills, General Manager).

Meteorologist at WKMG News 6, and Lauraleigh Avery, Orange County
Emergency Manager, for providing a 2024 Hurricane Season Outlook and
best practices before, during and after a storm.

Furthermore, we'd like to thank the nearly **70 CFHLA Members** who attended and the **ten allied member sponsors who showcased their the products and services at the seminar.** 

Lastly, as a reminder, the 2024 Disaster Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday began last weekend and extends through next Friday, June 14.

This sales tax holiday includes a variety of disaster preparedness items such as: flashlights up to \$40; radios up to \$50; tarpaulins at \$100 or less; anchor systems or tie-down kits worth \$100 or less; fuel tanks up to \$50; small batteries — AA, AAA, C, D, 6-volt or 9-volt, not car batteries — up to \$50; food storage cooler up to \$60; portable generators worth \$3,000 or less; and smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers up to \$70 each. Also, many common household items and goods related to pets will be tax-exempt during the period as well.


